"But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount." (Luke 19.8)

Zacchaeus was the **chief** tax collector in his town. This means that he had used his influence, as a tax collector, to cheat others out of their money for his own gain while appeasing the Roman authorities. Zacchaeus, while being a shorter man, made up for it with the size of his bank account, which had grown to a substantial size from taking from others in his community. The community considered him a sinner because of his actions (vs.7). After an encounter with Jesus, he is radically transformed. His life, actions, and faith are different after being with Jesus. He is now sealed in faith. When we form a deep personal relationship with Jesus our lives cannot help but be transformed. We are no longer sealed in anything of this world but now sealed in faith.
