## *The Pastor's Message* *January-February, 2012*

### *Dear Members and Friends,*

As I write this letter, I am preparing to take a little bit of time off. It is the day after Christmas and I need some down time. I sometimes wonder what the Christmas season will be like for me when I get to retirement; what will it be like to not have to worry about and prepare for Christmas as a pastor? My guess is that the first year it will be relaxing but that after that I'll probably be looking for things to do. Taking this time apart will probably be like that; the first few days will be fine, but after that, I will probably grow restless with nothing to do. It's why the vacations I usually take are of the active variety rather than the "laying by a pool" variety.

Learning how to spend time quietly and in the presence of the Spirit of God is important for all Christians. We are gearing up for Project Homeless Connect and the Point in Time Count in Monmouth County which will take place on **Wednesday, January 25, 2012**. We anticipate being in Asbury Park, Freehold, Long Branch and Keansburg and possibly a very limited site in Red Bank to conduct the Point in Time Count.


We are in need of volunteers, **both bilingual and those who are not bilingual** to assist Monmouth County in the one day Point in Time count of the homeless. In conjunction with this, Project Homeless Connect will attempt to link homeless individuals and families with housing and other services in order to help them break the cycle of homelessness. At the Project Homeless Connect (PHC) sites, food and beverages, social services, and health screenings will be available, as well as "giveaways" such as warm clothing and toiletries.

We are looking for bi-lingual volunteers who speak Spanish, Portuguese or Creole to assist us

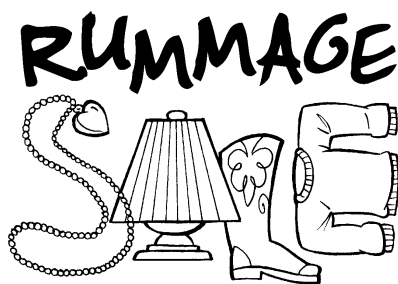
